Notes for the Guidance of Authors

The journal publishes both invited and contributed articles. Authors wishing to contribute articles to the journal should be submitted online to www.prkm.co.uk. Only papers written in English can be accepted for publication.

The first page should include the authors' names, affiliations, details of the corresponding author including telephone, fax and E-mail numbers. A contents list containing all the heading and subheadings should be provided. A summary of up to 250 words is required and a list of up to 10 keywords provided. The context should be established in the introduction. The author should retain a copy of the manuscript.

GRAPHICS: Tables should be typed separately using either the wordprocessor's table editor or tabs for formatting (not a mixture).

Diagrams, graphs and photographs should be designated as Figures and numbered sequentially throughout the text, Tiff or Eps format should be used.

The figure captions should be collected together at the end of the article. Where it is necessary to use an illustration that has been published elsewhere, the author must supply a copy of the illustration and obtain permission to republish it from the holder of the copyright. The permission should be forwarded with the manuscript.

ACCEPTANCE: The Editors are free to reject manuscripts (commissioned or otherwise) submitted to them, to suggest amendments and to make minor corrections. All possible care will be taken of manuscripts, but neither the Editors nor publishers shall incur liability in the event of accidental loss or damage.

Upon acceptance of an article by the journal, the author(s) will be asked to transfer copyright of the article to the publisher. This journal and the individual contributions contained in it will be protected by the copyright of Science Reviews 2000 Ltd.

PROOFS AND REPRINTS: Proofs will be sent to authors for the correction of typesetting errors only. Other alterations will be charged to the author. Offprints may be ordered when the corrected proofs are returned.
